INTRODUCTION

The Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Sciences (JNIMS) is located at Porompat in Imphal East District, Manipur. It is well connected and easily approachable from different parts of the state and spread over an area of 51.32 acres of land.

The Government of India Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Department of Health and Family Welfare) Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi has given the Permanent recognition of JNIMS for MBBS course vide its letter No. [U.12012/224/2015-ME(P.II)] dated 17th April 2015.

JNIMS, Imphal has got approval for increase of 50 MBBS seats (100 to 150 MBBS seats) by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, (MARB) National Medical Commission under u/s 261(1)(a)(b) and 28(1)(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 vide letter No. NMC/UGI/2022-23/000170/035872-81 dated 31st August, 2022 from academic year 2022-2023 JNIMS, Imphal has also got the renewal of permission for MBBS course for 4th Batch (2025 renewal) vide National Medical Commission, MARB vide letter no. Renewal/UGMEB/2023-2024/437 dated 10th June, 2025

AIMS & OBJECTIVES:

1. To provide advanced and specialized medical facilities of the highest level in all the specialties and to serve as a regional referral service centre for comprehensive health care and provide management consultancy in preventive, promotive, diagnostic, curative and rehabilitative services for the entire State of Manipur.
2. To provide undergraduate and post-graduate medical education and training in all identified fields of specialization at post-graduate level.
3. To provide and impart practical, and job oriented training including refresher courses in various specialties to medical and para-medical personnel sponsored by the state.
4. To address all aspects of primary health care programmes including health manpower development in the state and to provide consultation, advice and/or assist the state, government in regard to planning, establishing, managing and assessing the health and family welfare and medical education programmes and other related activities.
5. To assist the State Government in coordinating health planning and developmental activities especially in the organization of primary health care and health manpower development for the State.

6. To encourage, guide and assist the training and making available adequate number of required categories of skilled manpower at primary, secondary, and higher levels of health care.
7. To develop educational training facilities of the highest order for various types of Para-professional, supportive and auxiliary staff at all levels.
8. To conduct research, especially in operational, applied and other studies as related to health sciences and manpower development.
9. To hold examinations and grant such degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions and titles as may be laid down in accordance with the regulations.
10. To frame regulations specifying the manner in which the welfare of all grades of employees are addressed in order to bring a healthy and harmonic work culture in the Institute for the betterment of the healthcare of the society.
11. To do all such other lawful acts as are conducive or incidental to the attainment of the above objectives.

ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO MBBS:

The eligibility criteria shall be as laid down by the National Medical Commission which may be amended from time to time.

No Candidate shall be allowed to be admitted to the Medical Curriculum of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) Course until the conditions laid down by MCI/NMC and Manipur University are fulfilled.

*1. Provided also that to be eligible for NEET (UG) - 2025, the candidate must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology, and English individually and must have obtained a

minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Bio-technology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in the Regulations of NMC. In addition, they must have got a rank in the merit list of NEET (UG) - 2025 for admission to Undergraduate Medical Courses.

2. In respect of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, or Other Backward Classes (NCL), the minimum marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Biotechnology are taken together in the qualifying examination shall be 40% marks instead of 50% marks for Unreserved and General-EWS Candidates. In respect of PwBD candidates as per NMC Regulations, the minimum marks in the qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (or Botany & Zoology)/Biotechnology taken together shall be 40% instead of 50%."

Note:

- I. No candidate shall be admitted after the last date of admission as announced by the University and prescribed by NMC/MMC.
- II. No candidate is eligible for admission if he/she is found guilty misconduct or convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.
- III. The rules to be observed at the time of admission shall include criteria of standard of fitness.
- IV. Candidates should deposit prescribed tuition fees and other charges including caution money as notified by the Institute from time to time. Amount of Tuition fees etc. payable will be determined by the management of JNIMS. Fees once paid shall not be refunded.
- V. Amount of examination fees payable will be as prescribed by the University.
Tuition and hostel fees are shown in ANNEXURE-1. The last dates of payment of annual fees will be notified. In case, the fees are not paid within the stipulated dates notified a fine of Rs. 5.00 (Rupees five) per day will be charged up to one month from the due date. Subsequently, the name of the defaulters will be automatically struck off the rolls. Such defaulting students may however be allowed to join the course with the permission of the Director on payment of all dues and re-admission fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundreds only). Application for exemption of fine may be considered only in exceptional circumstances.

No student shall be permitted to join Para-clinical group of subjects until she/he has passed in all pre-clinical subjects. Supplementary Exams will be conducted with a gap of 1 month from the regular exams and results to be declared within 15 days. There shall be no supplementary batches. The remaining rules and regulations shall be as per CBME guidelines of 1st August, 2023.

SYLLABI, CURRICULUM, ATTENDANCE, DURATION OF COURSE AND EXAMINATION:

The syllabi, curriculum, attendance in class, duration of course and examination will be strictly as per rules and regulations laid down by MCI / NMC and Manipur University. Undergraduate students must attend a minimum of 75% attendance in lectures, seminars, group discussions, tutorials demonstrations and 80% Practical and Clinical Postings.

MIGRATION TO AND FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES:

Migration to and from this Institution shall be governed by the guidelines of the MCI/NMC as amended from time to time.

DISCIPLINE AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

All the students are required to conduct himself / herself in a disciplined & befitting manner and maintain the decorum both inside and outside the Institute premises.

Breach of discipline and failure to abide by the rules & regulations of the college, hostel or mess or if any student is found indulging in ragging or any other undesirable, illegal, antisocial or destructive activities in the Institute & Hostel premises or outside the Institute, he/she is liable to be fined or rusticated or expelled from the Institute. The Dean of the Institute shall have full authority for taking such disciplinary action.

RAGGING:

Definition of Ragging: Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts (as per the National Medical Commission Gazette notification vide no. UGMEB/NMC/Rules & Regulations/2021 dated 18th November, 2021)

Ragging includes the following:

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other students, including rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a fellow student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique of a fresher or a fellow student.

As per the National Medical Commission the following guidelines shall be strictly followed:

1. Every student shall furnish a character certificate from the institution where from he/she has passed his/her qualifying examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavior pattern specially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistent violent or aggressive behavior or any tendency to harm others.
2. An annual undertaking signed by each student, whether fresher or senior & his/her parent(s) jointly stating that each of them have read the relevant instructions/regulations against ragging as well as punishments, and that if the ward has been found guilty he/she shall be proceeded against, shall be procured.

Such an undertaking shall be furnished in the prescribed format given in annexure - III & IV, typed on a non-judicial stamp paper of prescribed value (By the Oath Commissioner) and duly signed in the presence of an Oath Commissioner. The same shall be submitted at the beginning of each academic year by every student.

The Institute has an ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE comprising of senior teachers of the institution, representatives of Civil & Police administration and local media and an ANTI RAGGING SQUAD, comprising of mainly hostel wardens and caretakers of the Institution.

ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE and identified persons will ensure that no ragging goes on in the premises of the Institutes.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given a chance to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory the authority would take up necessary actions. Administrative action in the event of ragging shall be as per MCI/NMC rules. Any person who indulges in ragging shall be dealt with severely as per the instructions on the subject.
